In addition, Mia Lewis will be providing entertainment from 7:30 am to 9:30am and Keith Hughes will be performing from 10:00am to noon. Fresh fruits and vegetables such as peaches, melons, raspberries, tomatoes, sweet corn and green beans are in season at the Market. Other items available include kettle corn, flowers, meats, honey, baked goods, and arts and crafts.
