



## TOUR THE TOWN ON THE TROLLEY!

CityBus and the Lafayette-West Lafayette Convention & Visitors Bureau provide a free guided trolley tour of our communities on Saturday mornings from May through August. The tours leave at approximately 9:40 a.m. and 10:40 a.m. from the northwest corner of Fifth & Main Streets, across from the Farmers' Market. Discover such things as where Eli Lilly got his start, where John Purdue lived, Louis Sullivan's "little jewel", what Mark Twain said about our courthouse and much more.

Of course, the free trolley runs a regular schedule throughout the year except on Sundays. The trolley usually runs every 10-15 minutes and stops are marked with signs.
